Mr. Ron Johnson owned his first camera back in 1980 and his first computer in 1985 while still in elementary school. Mr. Johnson also started his martial arts career in 1985. He also took a fascination with the camera's ability to do multiple exposures on a single frame (yes, this was before digital or Photoshop). He was also intrigued with computers and taught himself BASIC and PASCAL by Junior High. This also included taking apart the computer and putting it back together. During Mr. Johnson's high school years, he was running his own BBS and started a small business venture "Johnson Computer Consulting". He was even answering computer questions for his older friends that were in college for IT degrees. While in school he also took vocational courses in Photography & Printing.

Mr. Johnson graduated high school in 1991 and immediately entered the corporate realm. Several jobs that he held brought in clients that offered him better paying jobs with their companies. Word was getting out and companies wanted his talent and expertise. College was not even a thought at this time as the companies were paying for all the training. However, as with all good things an end was in sight. In 2002, the company that Mr. Johnson was presently working for announced that the entire IT department would be outsourced in two years. Everyone was being given a "heads up" that they would soon be unemployed. The IT world was changing. Companies were going out of the United States to save a buck and getting rid of the American workers.

Mr. Johnson spent the next two years investing in software and equipment to create "Johnson Digital Imaging". A company tailored towards digital photography and video for sports and martial arts. Mr. Johnson, by this time, was also a recognized Sensei "Martial Arts Instructor" and was running his own dojo "school" called the SeiKiDo Dojo (from 1995 until 2005). Sure enough, by June 2004 layoffs began at the corporation Mr. Johnson was working for and he was laid off with a six month severance.

It was during the month of September that Ron received information from Full Sail College in regards to obtaining a degree in Digital Media. He drove to Florida two weeks later to attend a tour of the campus. Upon his return, he put his house in Virginia on the market, finished up his business obligations and packed up his belongings. Mr. Johnson moved to Florida at the end of December 2004 to begin an accelerated curriculum at Full Sail (getting a four year degree in two years). This was a 24/7 college with a very demanding work load. Being the very first Bachelor's class that the college offered and starting out as a class of about forty people. Out of that forty, there were seven that never failed a course and graduated on time. Mr. Johnson was not only one of those seven, but only one of two that graduated with perfect attendance, never missing a class or lab the entire time.

Mr. Johnson freelanced in Florida during his college studies. He continued to freelance for about six months after graduating. However, the area was oversaturated with students doing work cheap for whatever cash they could pocket. This simply was not going to work out with rent and soon to be student loans to pay. Hence, Mr. Johnson returned to his home state of Virginia to investigate employment opportunities within a region he is well familiar with.
